Preference will be given to the applicants with a valid First Aid Certificate, a FoodSafe Certificate, and/or a valid driver's license. These positions are open to all youth 15-30 but preference will be given to current high school and post-secondary students returning to school in the fall and to Band members. Successful Candidates will be required to come in to do an interview process with ISETS to see if they qualify.
